Following the conference will be published Abstracts.

Applications for participation (see form below) and texts of papers should be sent as attachments to e-mail kurdynajulia@gmail.com for Organizing committee before April 1, 2017. Please indicate the topic of the mail "Conference-2017". File names must issue the following: name and initials of the author, file type (application, a text report), for example: Tyshchenko_R.zayavka Tyshchenko_R.tekst

The report - from 5,000 to 10,000 characters with spaces (including a list of references) in the editor Word, font Times New Roman, font size - 12, spacing - single.

On the first page is submitted the following information: name, surname, patronymic of the author (in the corner), academic degree, title author, name of the institution in which it operates, its email address.

Links to publications are cited in brackets where indicated edition serial number in the reference list and, after the comma, page number, as in [3, p. 165]; References shall be in alphabetical order and placed directly after the text.

The abstract should be informative, original research and answer grammar and stylistic standards. Later you will receive the confirmation of your participation in conference in e-mail.
