Regulations on Honorary Doctor and Honorary Professor of the Lviv Polytechnic National University

Approved by the Academic Council

of the Lviv Polytechnic National University Minutes № 60 dated 23rd December, 2019.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1.1. Regulations on the procedure for awarding honorary titles of the Lviv Polytechnic National University (hereinafter - the Regulations) were developed in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Education", the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education", the Law of Ukraine "On Science and Scientific and Technical Activities", the Charter of the Lviv Polytechnic National University (hereinafter the University), other normative legal acts and regulations.

1.2. Regulations determine grounds, conditions and procedure for awarding honorary titles at the University.

1.3. The University Honorary awards of collective recognition for special merits of citizens of Ukraine and other states in the development of democracy, science, culture and education are:

Honorary title "Doctor Honoris Causa of Lviv Polytechnic";

Title "Honorary Professor of Lviv Polytechnic."

2. GROUNDS AND CONDITIONS FOR AWARDING HONORARY TITLES

2.1. The honorary title of "Doctor Honoris Causa of Lviv Polytechnic" is awarded to outstanding Ukrainian and foreign scientists, statesmen, public and religious figures, organizers of higher education, whose activities and achievements are significant:

- for the development of science, education, culture;
- for the growth of national wealth, intellectual potential and authority of Ukraine;
- for the University development and its prestige.

2.2. The honorary title of "Doctor Honoris Causa of Lviv Polytechnic" can be awarded to:

- a world-renowned scientist who contributed to the establishment of a new direction of scientific research;
- a statesman or public figure, well-known in Ukraine, whose activities aimed at the development of science, education and culture, contributed to the growth of the University prestige and to training of scientists in the relevant field;
- patron, whose charitable assistance is a significant contribution to the development of material and technical base of the University;
- organizer of higher education the Head or representative of an International organization, Ukrainian or foreign universities, ministry or department, as well as other organizations - customers of intellectual services, which have contributed to the significant growth of the University prestige.

2.3. The title of "Honorary Professor of Lviv Polytechnic" is awarded to persons having significant achievements in scientific and pedagogical, educational, cultural and / or organizational work recognized in the history of the University development and formation.

2.4. The honorary titles are awarded by the decision of the University Academic Council.

3. HONORARY TITLES AWARDING PROCEDURE

3.1. Rector or Directors of educational and scientific institutes, Academic Councils of educational and scientific institutes, labour collectives of educational and scientific subdivisions (departments or institutes) may be the initiators of awarding honorary titles.

The initiator submits a proposal in the form of a reference-recommendation (according to the form given in the appendix) for consideration by the Attestation Commission of the University Academic Council.

3.2. The Attestation Commission analyzes the merits of the candidates and informs the Head of the University Academic Council and the initiator about the results of the proposal submitted.

3.3. With positive results of the proposal, the Attestation Commission studies public opinion, summarizes information about the candidate's activities, submits his/her case to the University Academic Council, and also determines the person who will deliver a laudatory speech.

A person delivering a laudatory speech may be a recognized specialist/scientist in the relevant field/branch or Vice-Rector of the University.

4. HONORING DISTINGUISHED PERSONS

4.1. At the University Academic Council ceremonial sitting, at the University labor collective conference or at other solemn events a person who has been awarded an honorary title receives Diploma, mantle and book edition (brochure) with the laureate's photo and brief biographical information including his/her special merits; a laudatory speech in honor of the laureate; inaugural speech / open lecture of the laureate.

4.2. A person who has been awarded an honorary title has the right to participate in a meeting of the University Academic Council.

4.3. Once a year a person who has been awarded an honorary title is guaranteed the opportunity to deliver a speech in front of the scientific and pedagogical staff and students of the University. All costs for such an event organization to be borne by the University.

4.4. A brief reference to distinguished persons and their photographs are provided in the University History Book (Chronicles), which is kept in the museum.

4.5. Information about distinguished persons is published in the University mass media.

4.6. The last names and first names of distinguished persons are inscribed on the commemorative plaques of Lviv Polytechnic.
