

Curriculum vitæ of Yuliana Myronivna Terletska

Yuliana Myronivna Terletska (maiden name Vary) was born on November 25, 1987 in the city of Stryi, Lviv region, Ukraine.

In 2005, she graduated from secondary school No. 83 in Lviv.

From 2005 to 2009, she studied at the Lviv State University of Internal Affairs, received a basic higher education in the field of training "Psychology" and obtained a bachelor's qualification in the field of psychology of human behavior and activity management (diploma with honors).

In 2010-2011, she studied at the Lviv State University of Internal Affairs, received a full higher education majoring in "Psychology" and obtained a master's degree in management psychology, a psychology teacher at a university (diploma with honors).

From March 2011 to August 2015, she worked as a teacher at the Department of Theory and Methods of Practical Psychology, Faculty of Psychology, Lviv State University of Internal Affairs.

In 2011-2014, she studied at a postgraduate course (with no break from production) of Vasyl Stefanyk Prykarpatsky National University, majoring in pedagogical and age-related psychology 19.00.07.

In 2014, she defended her candidate's thesis on the topic "The impact of social and economic deprivation of scientific and pedagogical workers on their professional activity" on 19.00.07 "Pedagogical and age-related psychology" at the National University "Ostroh Academy" and received the scientific degree of candidate of psychological sciences.

From September 2015, she continued her work at Lviv Polytechnic National University, first as a senior lecturer at the Department of Pedagogy and Social Management, and from September 2016 as an associate professor at the Department of Pedagogy and Social Management, which was reorganized in 2019 into the Department of Pedagogy and Innovative Education.

Since August 2022, he has been working as an associate professor at the Department of Theoretical and Practical Psychology of the Educational and Scientific Institute of Law, Psychology and Innovative Education of the Lviv Polytechnic National University.

The total teaching experience in higher education institutions is more than 11 years.

In 2018, she received a certificate in accordance with the All-European recommendation for language education in the languages of the European Union countries B2 (in English).

At the department of pedagogy and innovative education, she taught the following academic disciplines: "Conflictology", "Conflictology in the professional environment", "Basics of psychology and pedagogy", "Psychology", "Pedagogical ergonomics", "Psychopedagogy", "Psychopedagogy of work", etc.; at the department of theoretical and

practical psychology - "Psychology of conflicts and their resolution", "General psychology" and others.

While working at Lviv Polytechnic National University:

1) developed and placed in the virtual educational environment 7 educational and methodical complexes, for 5 of which she received certificates;

2) issued:

- 1 textbook (co-authored);

- 3 training manuals (co-authored);

- 9 methodical instructions (7 – co-authored and 2 individually);

At the moment, he has more than 130 works, of which more than 100 are scientific, of which:

1) monograph – 1 (in a foreign edition, in English);

2) sections of monographs in collective monographs published by European publishing houses -2 (published: 1 - in English; 1 - in Ukrainian);

3) a scientific article published in the International Scientometric Database Web of Science - 1 (co-authored, quartile Q4);

4) scientific articles published in the Scopus International Scientometric Database -6, of which: 2 – co-authored (quartile Q4); 4 – individual (1 – in the edition with quartile Q1; 1 – in the edition with quartile Q3; 2 – in the edition with quartile Q4);

5) scientific articles published in periodicals abroad in various International Scientometric Databases -5;

6) scientific articles published in specialized psychology publications in Ukraine – 13;

7) theses: 13 theses at international conferences abroad; 30 abstracts at international conferences in Ukraine; 15 theses at All-Ukrainian scientific conferences, etc.

Scientifically, he works on the problem of mental deprivation in humans, including scientific and pedagogical workers, and its impact on their professional activity.
