**Conference paper requirements**

Papers should be submitted in the \*.doc format to e-mail [ipagandpd@gmail.com](mailto:ipagandpd@gmail.com), indicating the section number.

Paper length – 2 – 5 pages, page format – A4 (297x210 mm). Margins – 20 mm. Font – *Times New Roman*, font size – 14, line spacing – 1,5. Paragraph indentation – 10 mm. The pages should not be numbered.

References to the sources used are written in the text in square brackets, indicating the sequence number of the source according to the reference list, adding a comma and the page number. The reference list should be given at the end of the text in alphabetical order.

*The first page should include:* 1) the authors' names and surnames, scientific degrees, academic titles, positions, affiliations (at the top of the page, right-aligned); 2) the paper's title (one space below, center-aligned, caps, bold font); 3) the main text (one space below).
