Procedure for preparing conference materials

The texts of the abstracts should be typed in Microsoft Word (main text – Times New Roman, 12 pt, line spacing 1.0), according to the following requirements:

1. The abstracts should be informative and should be full 1-3 pages of A4 format. The Organizing Committee accepts no more than two abstracts from a co-author. The number of co-authors is no more than three.
2. Abstracts should be prepared in Ukrainian (for foreign participants – in English).
3. Headings. The order of the material is as follows (each block should be printed after skipping one line): UDC number (left, capital letters, bold); title of the abstract in Ukrainian (middle, capital letters, bold); title of the abstract in English (middle, capital letters, regular); name (full) and surname of the author or co-authors (in the middle, lowercase, comma separated, bold); name of the organization and full mailing address (in two lines, in the middle, lowercase, italics); abstract in English (from the paragraph, italics, up to five lines); abstract in Ukrainian (from the paragraph, normal).
4. Page margins: top – 2.5 cm, left, bottom, right – 2 cm.
5. Figures and graphs in the article should be inserted across the page, depending on the size. Figure titles are Times New Roman, 10 pt, italics. All figures and graphs should be made as separate objects with sizes that correspond to the page parameters. Figures are signed and numbered (if there is more than one) below the figure, in the center of the text (abbreviation: Fig. number). Figures in *.tif, *.psd, *.jpg formats (resolution not less than 300 dpi) are imported into a Word file. Black-and-white drawings created in Excel, Visio Drawing, WordPad, CorelDRAW are imported into a Word file.
6. Tables are presented as separate objects in MS Excel or MS Word format. The table is assigned a number with a title (centered, italics) 10 pt. The main text of the table is presented in 10 pt.
7. Formulas are presented in the format Equation 3-5, aligned in the center of the text and numbered in parentheses on the right edge. Font by definition of MS Word: regular – 11 pt, large index – 9 pt, small index – 7 pt, large character – 18 pt, small character – 11 pt.
8. Literature: Times New Roman, 11 pt, italics.
9. File names on electronic media should contain the name of the author (first co-author).

May 09, 2025 – the deadline for accepting applications for participation in the conference and electronic materials of abstracts for participation in the conference (by filling out a Google form or sending to the e-mail of the organizing committee)

May 15, 2025 (Thursday)

14:00 – 17:00 – the second plenary session;

May 16, 2025 (Friday)

10:00 – 16:00 – the third plenary session and panel discussions;

16:00 – 17:00 – summarizing and closing the online conference.

- traffic flows and traffic management systems;
- traffic safety and environmental characteristics of traffic flow;
